State of Ohio Emerging Technology Award
for Flexible Plasma Displays***

Imaging Systems Technology (IST) is pleased to announce that it has been selected to receive the State of Ohio 2005 Emerging Technology award for its research in Flexible Plasma Displays.

This award will be presented to Carol Ann Wedding, President, of IST in Columbus, Ohio on November 21, 2005. The award is presented to recognize the innovations and significant accomplishments of small technology-oriented companies in Ohio. The award honors companies that are making valuable progress in the advancement of current technologies or are on the cutting edge in pursuing new and emerging technologies.

IST has been able to complete much of its research with grants from the State of Ohio Third Frontier Action Fund, The Advanced Technology Program (ATP) sponsored by NIST, and the National Science Foundation (NSF) Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) . These grants, along with an excellent team of engineers, have resulted in Imaging Systems Technology superceding technical milestones as well as developing an impressive Intellectual Property portfolio in flexible displays.
